Dear National Coordinators and Local Investigators of PROBESE, Dear Friends,

The first 18 patients of PROBESE have been randomized! Four months after the official call for centers we are proud to announce: PROBESE started out amazingly. The European Society of Anaesthesiology (ESA - Funding partner), as well as the European Society for Perioperative Care of the Obese Patient (ESPCOP) and different regional Societies of Anesthesiology (e.g. Germany, Italy) have endorsed our study. Until now, more than eighty centers confirmed participation, and National coordinators from different countries worldwide are involved in recruiting study centers. While the PROBESE collaboration is continuously growing, we would like to share some news regarding this endeavor with you.

National and local coordinators

At the end of this newsletter you will find a list of all national coordinators and local investigators as well as their current status regarding review board (IRB) application and on the Call-for-Centers (CFC) forms. Funding and Insurance issues

We must emphasize that PROBESE is an investigator-initiated trial. At current, there is no financial support. Therefore, case fees or other form of financial compensation for study related costs cannot be granted. Importantly, centers must provide insurance for their own study patients. In case of doubt, you can discuss country-specific regulations with the national and the international coordinators.

New study protocol version 2.4.2

Many IRBs have revised the study protocol thoroughly, suggesting improvements that do not interfere with approval in other centers. Changes in the protocol are summarized on the very first pages of the new version 2.4.2. Briefly, we skipped interim analyses, improved the description of



the statistical methods and the reporting of adverse events (appendix v.), and updated the study sheet (Appendix iv.). The new file "Study protocol_v2.4.2_PROBESE_with changes.pdf" should be used by centers that have not submitted the protocol for IRB application so far. If you have already submitted a previous protocol version (2.4.1 or older) to your IRB, don't panic: changes in the protocol have a formal character and can be submitted as amendments after approval.

Homepage

We would like to draw your attention to the study homepage (www.peg-dresden.de/probese). Here you can find updated files. As soon as national coordinators receive final ethical approval, translated versions of the study documents will be uploaded to that homepage. Certainly, you can also obtain all documents directly from the trial coordinator.

Applications for sub-studies are welcome!

We strongly encourage you to apply for sub-studies within PROBESE at the steering committee. We tried to pave the way by including different facultative outcome measures *per se* (e.g. spirometry), but please feel free to expand the knowledge that we may gain from this study. You may also consider networking with other PROBESE centers to increase numbers of patients for your sub-study. Applications will be considered on a first-in, first-served basis. Once approved by the steering committee, they will be announced at the study homepage. Please be aware that results from sub-studies can only be made public in any form (lectures, abstracts, conference contributions, papers etc) after the main study has been published and upon consent of the steering committee.

Further steps

As soon as you send us a copy of IRB approval for your center, you will receive two sets of logins into the PROBESE electronic case report form (eCRF): One login for pre- and intraoperative data entry (includes access to randomization), and a further login data set for pre- and postoperative data entry. Please note: Because of blinding, the person receiving the pre/intraoperative login is not allowed to use the pre/postoperative login and vice versa. To ensure blinding, there must be at least two assessors per patient at your center available.
